1. Joshua and Sandra are used car salespersons. They want to compare their pay for the month of June. They both worked **180** hours in the month of June and each of their sales totalled **\$25,000.00**

Joshua's Salary

- o He earns a base salary of \$1,000 per month
- He earns a **graduated commission** of **4%** on his first **\$10,000** of sales and **5%** on sales over **\$10,000**.

Sandra's salary

- o Sandra earns \$12.00 per hour.
- o Sandra earns straight 5% commission but only on sales over \$20,000
- a) Calculate the Gross Income of Joshua and of Sandra in the month of June.

- c) Which form of income would you rather have and why?



2. Walter works for company **A** and Kevin for company **B**. They want to compare their incomes from their employers. Both companies pay \$12.50 per hour. Walter and Kevin both have \$3,000.00 in sales and their hours worked are below:

Company A

- o Employees earn overtime at time and a half after 40 hours a week
- o Employees earn a 10% **commission** on sales **over \$1,000.00**

Company B

- Employees earn overtime at time and a half after 8 hours worked in a day
- o Employees earn 5% commission on all sales
- a) Determine how much Walter and Kevin earn [gross] for the week.

Rounding hints:

Rounding Decimals

Find your place and look next door.

5 or greater, add one more.

All digits in front, stay the same. All digits behind, zero's the name.

Round 1.362 to the nearest hundredths.

1.362 1.360

We look next door and find the number 2. 2 is less than 5 and so 6 remains the same.

Round 25.378 to the nearest tenths.

25.<u>3</u>78 _____ 25.<u>4</u>00

We look next door and find the number 7. 7 is more than 5 and so we increase 3 to 4.
