 - 3. Be a Yellowquill University College Mature Student High School Diploma program graduate entering full-time post-secondary studies in fall 2022
 - 4. Provide proof of application to a post-secondary institution. The winning recipients must provide proof of acceptance prior to release of scholarship money.
 - 5. Complete and submit an application by the closing date
 - 6. Use marks earned at Yellowquill University College in the graduating year
